What a blessing it was to accompany my ROA directors into prison and watch them evangelize! We all went dorm-to-dorm and cell-to-cell evangelizing. Forty-eight souls at Kilby were saved!

PRAISE THE LORD!! Two inmates, Sergio and Fernando (who attended all three nights of Spanish services) received Christ on the last night of the services. They had trusted in "a change" or "turning over a new leaf" to get them to heaven. God opened their eyes and let them see that salvation is not a religion, but a relationship. If you could only have been there and seen the utter peace on their faces, you'd be revived like I am right now. Three other hispanics in the room burst out in spontaneous praise upon seeing their "compadres" receive Christ.

PLEASE PRAY THAT WE WOULD BE ABLE TO GET TO NEW MEXICO SOON! With fifty-nine percent of the prison population there being Hispanic, the need is VERY great in the prisons of the Southwestern United States.
