

I just got back to the US from a scouting trip for a missions opportunity in Paris, France.

Why was a missionary to Ireland in Paris? This summer God has allowed me the opportunity to serve on a trip being put together by my missions board to take the Gospel to the world as the world comes to Paris for the Olympics!

For 3 weeks we will be leading teams doing street evangelism at 5 of the largest tourist destinations in Paris. Millions of people from all around the world will be coming for the Olympics and this may be their only time to hear about Jesus. 500,000 Gospel tracts will be passed out over the 3 week outreach event.





The tracts we are developing take people to a website where they can read and see a Gospel presentation in their language, and we will work to connect people with Bible-preaching churches in their home countries.

The other leaders I get to serve alongside on this trip are: Bob Hutton- the missions pastor from my sending church, Randy and John Laase- two missionaries serving in France who are sent out of Canton Baptist Temple, and Ben Roy- a Canadian Bible college student who is fluent in French. We spent multiple days meeting and planning so we are prepared for the teams coming this summer.

We still have spots available for this event! I'd love to see some of my supporters come and serve alongside me this summer, and there are 3 different weeks people can choose from if they are interested in coming.
