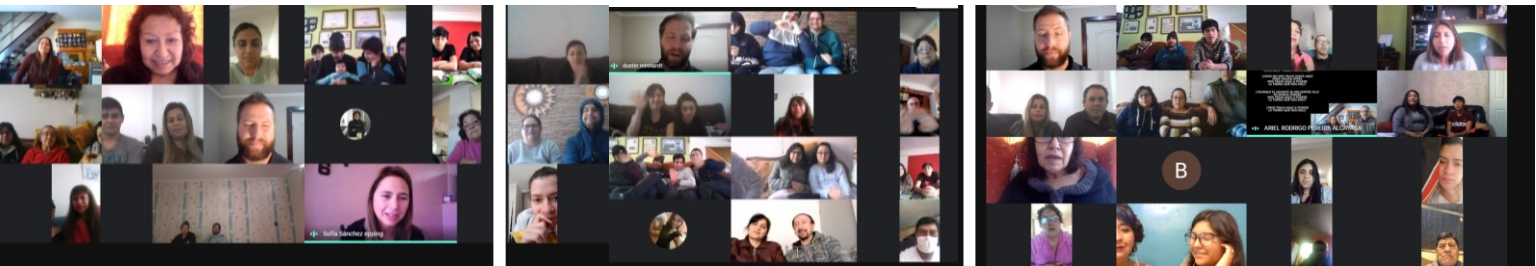

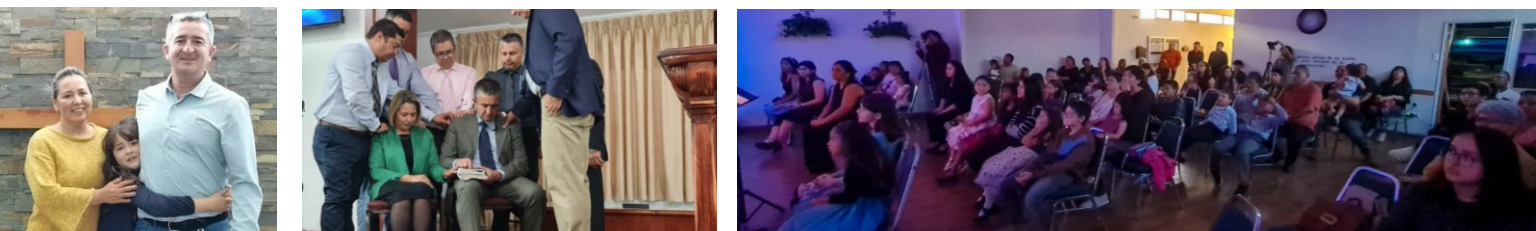

We focused a great deal on developing our Christian camp, with over 50 teens attending from the churches in Arica, Iquique, Gracia, Hospicio, and Copiapó.
