I have seen the oncologist here in Missouri, and we are looking at a new plan for the treatment of my CLL. It is genetically matched to my DNA, but also quite costly. The doctor's office and our insurance are working the details out, and I should begin soon with this pill treatment every 12 hours. We delayed our return to Kenya by a few months; to allow time to make sure I handle the treatment well and are making sure this recommended treatment has a doctor that can monitor it there in Nairobi. I want to get back home and serve Him all I can with whatever time is left. In the meantime, I have had to have 2 more units of blood, but am feeling fine now.
