One thing we have learned is that children grow as fast as ministries. Africa, Panama, and now Albania. The Lord has already placed us on three different continents as part of our international prison ministry.

Thank you all for your prayers in support of our Albania trip. The Lord was with us and allowed for several opportunities to be a blessing to others. The journey started with a Bible Revival in Kisha Baptiste Berakah Church. We began the week with an English-speaking service so that Aaron Wilson's family could get a taste of home, but the remaining services were preached with an Albanian interpreter. It was a joy to see the Lord move across the waters, just as He does in America. As part of prison prevention, we visited the gypsy camps where we met many families living much like our homeless here in the States. We shared candy and Christ as we handed out Bibles and Gospel tracts to adults and children alike.

It seemed as if the ten days were gone in the blink of an eye, but not before our first meeting with the Director of Prisons. She was very welcoming; however, we all know government officials love their paperwork. We were asked for a letter of intent to be sent along with our background checks through their chain for approval. There were many miles traveled for this important step, but we must start at the top of a long list of protocols when dealing with the prison system, especially internationally. We are asking for the Lord to move on hearts and open these doors. There are twenty-two prisons in this small country housing over six thousand inmates, and they need Jesus!
