No one was saved, but the seed was planted and the Word of God was proclaimed.

In February we attended our church's Mission Sunday and the Lord moved and worked in our hearts. We were challenged in the efforts of our giving to Faith Promise Missions. The month of February was steady as well with meetings. We had a couple of open dates, so we dropped in on a few churches where we were allowed to present our burden. From these visits, we were also able to book another meeting. Praise God! I had to attend additional training to update my Blue Card in order to minister at an institute and have another training on the calendar for another prison coming up.

I covet your prayers as I will be at a prison institution on the 5th of March. This prison has a drug program for inmates to take while incarcerated. Please pray that souls will be saved and lives changed. Those men are dealing with addiction problems and the only hope that they have is the Lord Jesus. I will also be at another prison in NC on the 21st of March.

Please pray that God will continue to watch over us as we travel on the road during deputation. Aisha will be leaving her full-time job at the end of March to stay home with our boys. We desperately desire your prayers that He will open more doors for us and that our calendar will be filled.
