Then at the other facility we had a great time in the meeting with those men, worshipping and praising the Lord. I was able to preach there as well and gave those men the gospel of our Lord Jesus. Then at the closing of the services another man came forward to the altar and wanted to talk to me about getting saved. When he came up to me, I reached out my hand to shake his and ask his name, his response was "you don't remember me do you?" I couldn't recall this man, but he told me his name which sounded familiar and that we were in the Rowan County jail together. I looked him in his eyes and said, "you knew who I was during our time there and if the Lord Jesus can save someone like me and change my life, he can do it for you to!!" I took him to the scriptures and showed him how he can be saved. He bowed his head and called upon the Lord to save him. Praise God! After he asked the Lord to save him, he looked at me and said, "I heard that you were a preacher now." Please pray for us that our testimony reaches behind those prison walls.

Will you please pray the Lord opens more doors for us to share our burden, testimony and calling to the prisons of America. Our summer months are not as full as we'd like but we trust the Lord for his provision.
