We have bought some folding chairs, a folding table, and a refrigerator, but have not yet purchased a stove.

It was a joy and encouragement to go out soul winning on Saturday. It strengthened our spirits to fellowship with God's people and to tell people about Jesus. Just this morning, our car would not start after a

shopping trip to the Trini version of a hardware store and God brought a man to us to give a tract to. He was not able to talk for long but was interested in church. Would you pray that Chris would get saved and come to church? Also, it was a very minor thing that needed adjusted to get our car running.

It looks like God may be trying to change our original plan for visas, and we may need to get our Missionary permits sooner than we had planned, Would you also pray that God would give us wisdom on what to do and when and how to do it? The immigration officer that interviewed us on the way in said if we ever tried to do this again we would be refused entry and sent home.
