They are stateless and invisible, and have fled their country with no hope. We are able also to bless their families with some food and necessities if needed. We are able to give them a true hope amidst their hopelessness. And that hope is Jesus.



Bring in the New! MTB W/ WILD'S CHRISTIAN CAMPS



We have been in consultation with the Camps USA, the Wild's to set up their first Christian youth camp for Burmese refugee youth this year in early October. They have approved our partnership and have committed to this innovative camp for Burmese refugees at the border in Thailand. We are so grateful to God. They have devotional materials in Burmese and will train our Burmese Christian counsellors (who took our ESL/Bible course and so speak some English). Please pray that we will get a harvest of Burmese youth.

Solar is in and planting has begun. In the picture you can see the trellises used for planting gourds. They have also planted onions. We are waiting to plant either rice or another staple, and more fruit trees. We are also waiting to stock the pond with fish. We will use Agape for growing food and fish to be distributed for evangelism. Also we have an outdoor meeting place to have Bible study with the rural poor there. It has already been used for Bible study! We also have good news. The neighbor has agreed to let us use their well! We now need a filter to make the well water potable.






MTB RADIO: Praise!
