It's hard to believe we are nearly halfway through 2024! We are thankful to look back and see how the Lord has guided the ministry in Ambato, and we look forward to how He will continue to open doors of opportunity here in our new city.

April 30, we moved to Tumbaco to start another church. We are asking God for wisdom as we witness and seek for new converts. Currently we are holding Bible studies in our home on Wednesdays. We rented a storefront on Sunday, June 3 at 9 am, and by 10am we had our first Sunday service. We praise the Lord as around 30 kids and adults trickled in to hear the gospel. The building is big enough to seat around 100 people, and it has a park directly in front. We will be building our own structure behind it for use as a children's church and nursery. We are also holding kids' clubs on Saturday in our barrio and are hoping to be able to start a bus route soon.

We ask that you pray for a special evangelistic campaign June 21-23 with a group coming down from Walker Bible Baptist Church in New York. We are praying that the Lord would allow us to see souls saved and that some families would be added to the church.

On April 4, our second baby boy, Beckett Adam, was born! We are grateful that there were no complications. He is 2 months old and growing.
