Dear Mr. and Mrs. Patriarca,

Project Dorcas is looking for sponsors for our upcoming projects in the next few days. Pensacola Christian College summer mission team to the Philippines will be with us for a week and we have several activities lined up. We will visit 4 of our mission churches and also have a joint evangelistic campaign for the male and female inmates at the prison. Having young Americans always bring out the crowds. We are expecting around 50 families per mission church and we would like to give each family a bag of rice, eggs and a kilo of hotdogs. Our mission churches are located in very rural areas and are among the poor. Project Dorcas aims to share God's love in a tangible way. Most families have many children and they are very undernourished and usually only eat one meal a day. By God's grace we will be able to share the gospel with 200 families and also bless them with food packs to help sustain a meal or two. One bag of food cost 660 pesos. To make up 200 food bags we are praying for 132,000. Then for the male and female inmates we will share the gospel with 200 inmates and then we would like to graciously bless them with toiletry kits. The kit will contain a bar of soap, travel size shampoo, toothpaste and toothbrush and for the ladies we would add sanitary napkins as well. Inmates simply rely on toiletries given to them by their visitors or civic organizations. There are over a thousand inmates but the warden has granted 200 inmates to come out in the quadrangle for us to hold our evangelistic meeting. The cost for a toiletry kit is 330 pesos and so for 200 kits we need 66,000. Please prayerfully consider helping us to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ and tangibly share God's love.
