We continue going house to house bringing the gospel and handing out tracts that clearly explain the gospel. There are people who receive the tract from us, but do not have time to listen, others who do not want to receive a tract, very few people who stop to listen. When there is no one in a house, we leave a tract with the message of the gospel, but despite the apathy of the people we always find someone who the Lord touches their heart. She also has two daughters who showed interest in congregating, please pray for them and may the Lord give us the grace and power to preach His word.

My wife also organizes a monthly ladies' meeting and thank God the Lord has used these meetings to encourage the sisters and invite someone new, such is the case of Laura, a mother of a girl who comes to church, who has already done profession of faith and has come to the meetings a few times.

Thank you for your prayers for the church land, we had been praying for one in particular that was more central, but in the end, it could not be finalized because it had a lot of debt, we found another a little further to the shore in a Colonia that is growing, this one is three times bigger than the previous one and with the same price, we see the hand of the Lord. We are in the final procedures for the final signing of the purchase. Thank God for churches in Mexico and the US as well as some brethren in particular who have offered for this cause. We only ask you to help us pray for some payments that we still need due to the taxes paid to the government, also for what follows, which would be the construction, but I know that the Lord is faithful and He will provide.

Thank you, very much dear brethren, for your prayers and support through your missionary offerings, thank you for participating with us bringing the gospel to the Uruguayan people, Jews and Gentiles. May the Lord bless you and continue to use you greatly.
